What do I do now?

Someone very dear to you has passed away:

At Home:

Call your doctor's surgery for your GP or a locum to visit and certify that death has occurred. Telephone your chosen Funeral Director for further advice as to what to do next. They will be able to arrange to come and collect your loved one at a suitably convenient time and take them into their care. You may call at any time of the day or night.

At a Nursing Home:

The Nursing Home staff will make all the immediate necessary arrangements for certification. They will also contact a Funeral Director of your choice, who will bring your loved one into their care. You can then contact the Funeral Director when you are ready, for further help and advice.

At Hospital:

If the death was expected


The Medical Examiner will issue a 'medical certificate of cause of death', which is needed before you can register the death. They will give the certificate directly to the registrars and let you know once they have sent it. You will then have 5 days to register the death.

The Funeral Director will arrange to bring your loved one into their care directly with the hospital.

If the death was not expected

The hospital might need to do a post-mortem examination to find out the cause of death. If they're unable to find out the cause, the doctor will contact the Coroner (or Procurator Fiscal in Scotland) who will investigate further.

The coroner will issue a medical certificate of cause of death when they've finished their investigation. Sometimes, an 'interim' certificate is issued whilst further investigations are taking place. A funeral director can then bring your loved one into their care. This can be arranged directly with the hospital, the Funeral Director will make the arrangements on your behalf.





A sudden or unexpected death:

Any death that occurs suddenly or unexpectedly whether at home, following an operation possibly, or an accident will be reported to the Coroner. This will also be the case if someone is in hospital less than 24 hours prior to death.

If this is necessary he/she will usually be contacted either by your GP, the hospital doctor or the police. Once a Coroner is involved he may wish to conduct a post mortem in order to establish the cause of death but you will be informed if this is the case.

The Coroner's Officer will keep you informed of the procedures but you may wish to contact your Funeral Director for further assistance and advice.


A Coroner's post mortem may result in the holding of an inquest and depending on the outcome may possibly delay the funeral but the Coroner's Officer will speak to you about this.

Registration of Death

Registration of the death will always take place in the area where death has occurred and needs to be done within 5 days. The cost of the certificates are £12.50 each if bought on the day.

Clarification of which Registrar of Births and Deaths to attend can be obtained from your Funeral Director, the Nursing Home, Hospital Patient Affairs Officer/Bereavement Office or the Coroner's Officer.

We have listed the details of our most local Registrars of Births and Deaths and the information you will be required to take with you.

Certificates provided by
Registrar of Deaths and their uses explained

Certificate for Burial or Cremation—this is a Green coloured document which is required by the Funeral Director.

A white form which is required for Social Security purposes.


Certified Copy of Entry of Death—this will be required for probate purposes, by banks, building societies, insurance companies, etc. You will more than likely need several copies of this so it is best to order them whilst at the Registrar's to save any delay later. A photocopy will not be accepted in place of an original.

Should a Coroner's post mortem have taken place then the Coroner's Officer will advise you when and where to attend for registration.

If a burial is the chosen form for the funeral then in most cases the above documents will be issued.

If cremation is the chosen form for the funeral then the Certificate for Burial or Cremation will not be issued but a different form will be issued direct to the Funeral Director.

However if there is to be an inquest then the Certified Copy of Entry of Death will be replaced by an interim certificate.





The Next Step

You will now begin considering the type of funeral that would be most appropriate for your loved one.

Your loved one may have left specific instructions regarding the type and format of their funeral. These may be included in their will or documented within a pre-paid funeral plan.

If this is the case, some decisions may already have been made, and you can approach your Funeral Director with these instructions and any relevant documentation.

If no specific instructions have been left, the choice will be yours. This may include deciding between burial or cremation, as well as the location and style of the service.

As your Funeral Director, we are here to guide and support you through every step of the process. We can assist with all necessary arrangements and bookings, including liaising with churches, celebrants, cemeteries, and crematoria to coordinate a suitable date and time. We will, of course, discuss all options with you beforehand to ensure everything is arranged according to your wishes.

A funeral does not need to be religious, nor does it need to follow a traditional format. We are here to support all preferences and will work with you to create a service that is most meaningful and appropriate for your loved one.

We provide a service for all, respecting and accommodating every culture, tradition, and belief, including non-religious perspectives. Our role is to support and guide you—every decision remains entirely yours.


Our telephone lines are open during normal working hours. We are available 24 hours a day to bring your loved one into our care.

Things to do after death

- Register the death (usually within 5 days in England)
 - Obtain certified copies of the death certificate
 - Locate the will and any pre-paid funeral plan
 - Inform family members and close friends
 - Use the “**Tell Us Once**” service to notify multiple government departments at once (including HMRC, DWP, DVLA, and Passport Office)
 - Contact banks, building societies, and other financial institutions
 - Notify utility providers (gas, electricity, water, telephone, internet)
 - Inform the landlord, housing association, or mortgage provider
 - Return official documents such as passports and driving licences
 - Notify insurance providers (life, home, car, travel, etc.)

 - Contact the employer and arrange any workplace matters
 - Cancel or transfer subscriptions, memberships, and services
 - Redirect or manage post through Royal Mail
 - Make arrangements for pets or dependants, if needed

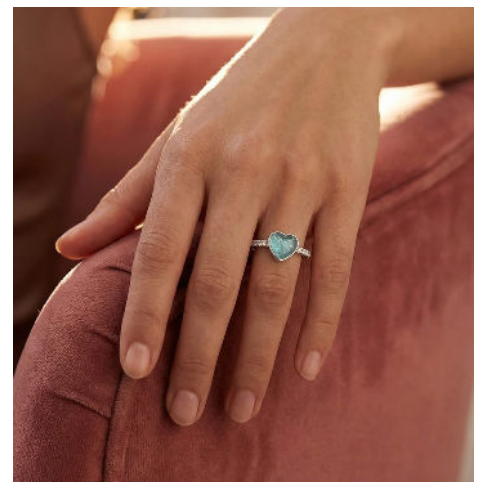
Cremated Remains & Memorials & Jewellery


